The student's application will NOT be considered complete until this essay has been received.
- Fee: A \$30.00 fee is charged to apply to this Choice Program for students that are NOT zoned for AJMS. If you ARE zoned for AJMS, you do not need to pay the fee.
- <u>Teacher Recommendations</u>: Please enter 2 of your student's current teachers email addresses into the application, and the forms will be sent directly to them to complete.

 - 2023 January FAST Reading and Math test scores
 - Handwritten Essay
