- Promote a culture of respect, responsibility & safety throughout our school
- Reduce behavior disruptions
- Foster appropriate learning environments to facilitate success for all students

What can I do with my STAR Tickets?

Students use STAR Tickets to purchase snacks, trinkets, games, toys, prizes and special privilege vouchers such as lunch with the principal.
