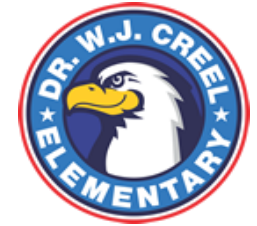

### School-Family-Student Compact for Learning

<b>School academic goal(s) and/or focus area(s)</b>	Teachers and staff will collaborate and provide best instructional practices focusing on standards-aligned instruction to achieve and increase student proficiency and mastery in ELA, math and science.
<b>Working together for success:</b> In the classroom	Teachers and staff will provide a high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that supports students in meeting Florida's State Standards. Parents and families will be given an overview of "What their Child is Expected to Learn" for their child's specific grade. Through parent involvement events, parents and families will be given resources in each content area that align to Florida's state standards to be able to successfully work with their child at home.
<b>Working together for success:</b> At home	Teachers and staff will maintain records of student academic progress and inform students, parents and families through FOCUS, interims, progress reports, and parent/teacher conferences. Parents and families will be encouraged to check student planners and review graded work and assignments to promote academic achievement. Parents and families will also ensure students maintain regular attendance and are on time to school.
<b>Working together for success:</b> Student responsibility	Students will share the responsibility to improve academic achievement by coming prepared for class and completing classwork and homework assignments. Students will be responsible for monitoring their learning, asking for help when needed, and believing in themselves to try and do their personal best.
<b>Communication:</b> Staying informed	Teachers and families will use student planners, parent-teacher conferences, and technology platforms such as Class Dojo, Google Classroom, FOCUS, school Facebook page, Smores biweekly school newsletters from administration to families and monthly Smores school newsletters to families. There will be an Open House and Title 1 Annual Meeting once a year.
<b>Building Partnerships</b>	Participate in school activities as much as possible (Virtual Math Night, Science Night, Literacy Night, Coffee with the Counselors) Volunteer to serve on SAC and PTO.
