Attend Informational meetings at Cocoa High and be active in the Cocoa community. Support student in being active at school in clubs, sports and other activities.	Join clubs, sports and other activities at school and in the Cocoa community. Participate in class in appropriate ways and support peers in their active participation.
Communication: Stay Informed	Post grades and classroom information weekly. Participate in Open House, parent-conference nights, ESE meetings, and parent-teacher meetings.	Inform counselors or administrators about issues inhibiting students in reaching educational and post-secondary goals. Check FOCUS regularly, attend parent-teacher conferences. Stay connected with counselor regarding progress towards graduation.	Check FOCUS regularly and discuss academic progress with teachers and parents. Discuss any issues in reaching educational and post-secondary goals with guidance counselor, teachers, or an administrator.
Learning Environment	Create and maintain a safe learning environment for all students. Treat all students and families with respect.	Encourage and support the educational needs and goals of the student. Create a space for student to study at home. Provide a literature rich home environment.	Attend school daily for the entire school day. Treat all staff and peers with respect. Participate in class appropriately and work cooperatively with peers in class and in the Cocoa community.
