### SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

- Eau Gallie High School’s first graduating class was in 1964. The school has evolved from a neighborhood school to a school of choice offering a first in the state Aviation Program. We also offer a Fine Arts Academy, Health & Wellness Academy as well as the international Cambridge AICE Program
- Faculty and staff include 102 teachers serving roughly 1600 students in grades 9-12
- Demographics: **Enrollment 1600**; 19.28% Hispanic; 58.4% Caucasian; 11.85% African American; 2.7% Asian; 7.5% Multi-Racial

## GRADING AND RANKING

- The school year is divided into two semesters and four 9 week grading periods. The 2020-21 school year is a 4x4 block schedule due to COVID 19.
- Class Rank is based on the *cumulative un-weighted* GPA
- Eau Gallie High School uses a 4.0 grading scale
- Weighted GPA is the cumulative weighted grade point average including additional weight for Dual Enrollment and Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) courses, as well as Level III (Advanced) high school courses.

## EXTERNAL EXAMINATIONS

### CAMBRIDGE ASSESSMENT INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION

During the June 2021 testing session, 413 Cambridge students tested in 771 exams. There were 60 students entered for the AICE Diploma with 75% earning the AICE Diploma. There were 27 students who earned it with Merit and 5 earned it with Distinction.

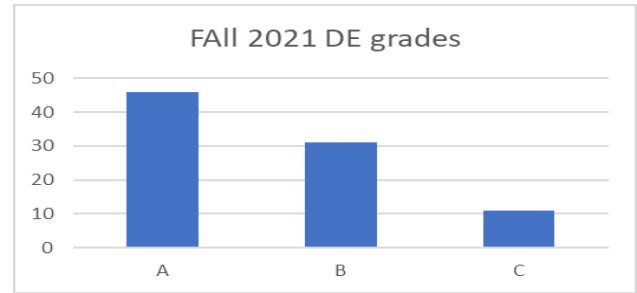

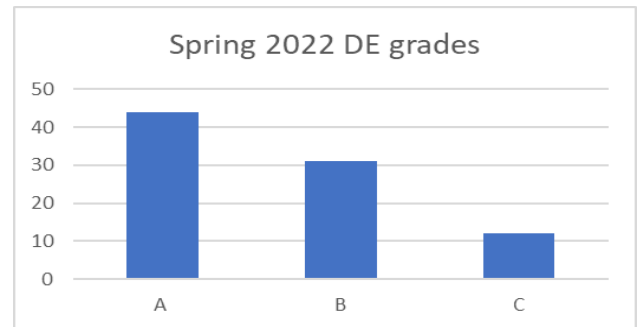
## OTHER ADVANCED PROGRAMS (DUAL ENROLLMENT)

In the Fall, 95 students tested in 215 courses at Eastern Florida State College

with 46% of students passing with an A, 31% of students passing with a B, and 11% passing with a C.



In the Spring, 104 students tested in 204 courses at Eastern Florida State College; 44% of students passing with an A, 31% of students passing with a B, 12% of students passing with a C.
