Over 50 Historically Black Colleges & Universities will be represented and providing information about their school and programs, to include on-the-spot scholarships and early acceptances provided for eligible high school seniors. Through the generous support of the event hosts, transportation and lunch will be provided for Brevard students in 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade that are eligible and interested in attending.
