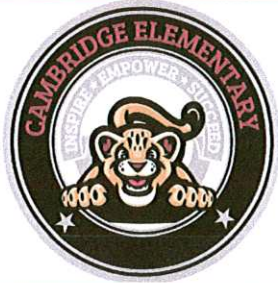

MATH & READING TIPS!

Math: Don't be afraid to leave a problem. Ask your child, "Would you like to come back to it later?" Giving your child the permission to choose whether to continue or not is empowering. Just make sure they complete required work later.

Reading: Reading regularly at home provides children with the practice they need to become great readers. Remember, "The more kids read, the better they read," and the same holds true for the opposite effect, "the less kids read, the poorer they'll read." Beyond practice time, reading at home reinforces a positive attitude around reading—kids start to enjoy reading!
