- Acquisition of new materials is based on reader interest, support of state academic standards and aligned curriculum, and the academic needs of students.

- Reputable, professional peer-reviewed journals or crowd-sourced reviews must be consulted during the process of selecting materials.
- Media Advisory Council will participate in the selection of new materials.
- Stakeholders will be invited to a School Advisory Council meeting to provide input on books selected for the library collection.
