**Minimum Program Requirements:**

- Must be at least 16 years of age and not enrolled in a K-12 program (A minor must have written parental or guardian consent to participate in the program.)
- Physically capable of performing the work of the trade

- Must complete CareerSource Brevard eligibility requirements for work experience opportunity.
