

## Dual Enrollment Update:

New Process, New Deadlines, Please read ALL of the information!

We know there will be hiccups along the way with a new process, but we are so excited for this new process! This means no longer going back and forth through email to guarantee you get in the classes you need and want.

\*Remember a student must have a current, unweighted 3.0 GPA to qualify. Students must also have room on their schedule to accommodate Off Campus periods for college classes. One class = one period off.\*

First - There will be NO flexibility with deadline dates. **Deadlines are hard deadlines!** This is an Eastern Florida State College rule.

Registration will now be online (no more Dropbox!) and **MUST** take place on Viera's campus or EFSC's campus under the guidance of School Counselors and/or EFSC advisors. Only classes on the approved list will be allowed. Students must have a signed DERF to register on an EFSC campus. Please see EFSC website for Lab times. Students will not be allowed to register themselves at home.

There is no longer Add/Drop week in January for Dual Enrollment students. Therefore, it is no longer possible to wait for first semester grades to qualify for Dual Enrollment.

The Spring 2024 Schedule will go live on the EFSC's website on October 9<sup>th</sup> to allow students and parents to browse prior to registering for classes.

### Deadlines:

- **Monday, October 9<sup>th</sup>:** Last day to submit a dual enrollment application to EFSC and to submit test scores to Viera
- **Thursday, October 19<sup>th</sup>:** Last day to complete any outstanding admissions requirements, such as new student orientation and advising appointments.
- **Monday, November 6<sup>th</sup>:** EFSC Spring Registration opens.
- **Friday, November 17<sup>th</sup>: LAST DAY for SPRING REGISTRATION!**
- **Monday, December 4<sup>th</sup> to Thursday, December 14<sup>th</sup>:** Spring Schedule Change Window for Dual Enrollment Students. Only students with EXISTING registrations can make schedule changes with the approval of a School Counselor.

We will be sending out another email with how to sign up for times to register in the Guidance Office with an EFSC advisor and School Counselor present. Please be on the lookout! We can't wait for this to be better for all students to instantly get the classes they need.
