The BPS FOCUS Mobile App is Available!

The BPS FOCUS mobile app will allow parents to quickly monitor a child's academic progress and view assignments, grades and attendance throughout the year. Parents can also choose to receive school news in the app and view school social media posts where applicable. This app is a companion to the BPS Mobile App that provides emergency notifications and messages to parents. Both apps are available through the Android and Apple stores and can be found by searching for **BPS FOCUS**.

Parents who already have an existing account won't need to re-register in FOCUS. You can use your same FOCUS login for the app!
