As a Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS) school, Audubon built our PBIS expectations that we use as a tool for teaching expected behaviors around S.O.A.R. Students are familiar with S.O.A.R and followed those expectations throughout the school last year. The letters in the acronym stand for **S**afety, **O**wnership, **A**chievement, and **R**espect.

The following information shows the expectation along with what the particular behaviors should look like throughout our school.

<b>Respect</b> <b>R</b>	Be mindful of working classrooms	Clean up after yourself	Value your surroundings	Follow the directions of the adults	Use kind words in your interactions with others
