We also take a group picture each month and place it on the school website.

Class of the Quarter

This is a competition between Homerooms in each grade level. At the end of each 9 Week grading period we tabulate a combined score for each Homeroom based on Academics, Attendance, and Behavior. The Homeroom with the best grades, best attendance (all periods), and lowest discipline referrals is declared the Class of the Quarter.
