Upcoming State Tests

Beginning next week we have a series of state test that will impact a small portion of our student body. It is a “retest” window for the FSA Reading & Writing test, and the Algebra 1 EOC Exam. This is for students who may have not taken one of these assessments in the past, or have not achieved a passing score. It is a relatively small number of students, but the students **do need to take the tests** as they are state graduation requirements.

Senior Survey

Just a heads up that Seniors will be asked to participate in a national survey in Homeroom on February 26th. The survey is conducted by the University of Michigan. It is a research based survey designed to **gather insight from graduating Seniors** across the country. We have participated in the survey in the past.

Free Food Service Program Extended

The United States Department of Agriculture issued an updated meal flexibility waiver to extend the Summer Food Service Program through June 30, 2021. This to ensure children continue to have access to nutritious meals during the coronavirus pandemic. This flexibility allows Brevard Public Schools to offer meals at no charge to all students through the end of the school year. This is main menu items only, not a la carte items.
