Registration Paperwork for Next School Year

Yes, we still have to collect registration paperwork for each student every year. We have two options for beginning the paperwork process.

- Online (sort of): The district has created a completely fillable document that can be accessed at any time on our website. The document can be filled out using your computer, but still has to be printed, then signed and turned in. You **cannot** submit the document electronically, it must be printed out and turned in.
- Traditional: The other option is to get a hard copy from us and complete it, sign it, and return it. This year we are required to have live signatures and hard copies of all forms. No electronic signatures or emails of documents can be accepted.

Face Coverings

As each day passes it seems that the discussion about masks and face coverings takes a different twist and turn. However, we have not been made aware of any changes to our policies – yet. **As of today, we are still required to wear face coverings on campus when we cannot ensure 6 feet of separation.** Our School Board and district staff continue to review the guidance from the Brevard County Department of Health and determine any possible changes to our health and safety plans.

Exams for Grades 7 through 11

In just a few weeks we will close out the school year and administer exams in grades 7 through 11. These exams will be on June 2nd and June 3rd. We will utilize a special bell schedule on the exam days. Please note that all three school days that week are “early release.” Here is how it will go:

- Monday, May 31: No School – Memorial Day Holiday
- Tuesday, June 1: Early Release using our Friday Bell Schedule (all classes meet)
- Wednesday, June 2: Early Release using Special Bell Schedule (Exams in Blocks 1 & 3)
- Thursday, June 3: Early Release using Special Bell Schedule (Exams in Blocks 2 & 4)
- Friday, June 4: No school – Summer Vacation!

I have attached a copy of the Special Bell Schedule for June 2 and 3. We will also accommodate early sign out on exam days, but more info on that later.
