Renovations and Relocations

Throughout the summer we will be under construction as we replace the main air conditioning system for much of the campus and have some other renovations. During this work, we will relocate the Main Office to Building #15 – which is the building just west of the main office with the bicycle racks. Do not worry, we will post signs and you will be able to find us. The main office and the guidance department will all be in operation. We will be open all summer, except for the week of the July 4th Holiday.
