Testing Continues

This coming week we will continue to administer more standardized tests. We have more AP and IB exams to administer as well as some state “End of Course” exams (EOC). As these are smaller groups of students, **we will return to our normal bell schedule**. AP and IB will continue to test in the Performing Arts Center and the state tests will be primarily in the Media Center and computer labs. I want to thank everyone for their hard work and patience with testing so far.

Face Coverings

Earlier this week the Governor issued an Executive Order regarding some of the health and safety protocols state wide. His order does not directly affect schools. We operate under policies and procedures issued by our local School Board. As of today, there are not any changes to our current policies, specifically face coverings. **We are still required to wear face coverings on campus when we cannot ensure 6 feet of separation**. Our School Board and district staff are currently reviewing our health and safety plans and we will certainly share any changes if they occur.

Drivers Education Course

We are excited to announce that we are able to offer a Driver’s Education course on our campus this summer. **This is the “behind the wheel” course**. Completion of this course can earn an insurance discount! We will also offer this course on campus next year. There are some minimum requirements to take the course, such as the student must already have a learners permit.
