Monday Closure

As you know we did not have school this past Monday. The school district cancelled school and all school related activities because of the potentially dangerous weather associated with then Tropical Storm Eta. We have not received any word on whether we would need to make up this school day. In the past, the state has waived a certain number of days if the closure was due to severe weather, such as Hurricanes. So it is quite possible we will not need to make up the day. We will let you know if that changes.

Class of the Quarter
