Sales Surtax Renewal

You may be aware that the School District has placed a renewal of the half-cent sales surtax on the November Ballot. The funds that have been generated from the expiring surtax have yielded millions of dollars of renovations to school facilities all over the county. For Cocoa Beach Jr/Sr, the new Air Conditioning unit currently being installed on our campus to service both building 14 & 15, is funded from this surtax. We have had many other upgrades as well. Of note for Cocoa Beach Jr/Sr, **the renewed surtax would yield over 4 million dollars in improvements**, including a renovation to the track surface this coming summer, major roof repairs this coming summer, and a complete stadium renovation in year 5.
