

School Readiness Goals

1. Approaches to Learning

Children will develop the ability to self-regulate and manage their emotions in a variety of situations to increase independence and to enhance their ability to learn.

2. Social and Emotional Development

Children will create and sustain meaningful relationships with adults and other children, use problem solving skills to respond appropriately to others and build confidence in their own skills to fully engage in learning opportunities.

3. Language/Communication and Literacy

Children will develop early literacy knowledge and skills such as book appreciation, phonological awareness, alphabet knowledge, print concepts and early writing.



4. Cognition

Children will develop the ability to think, reason, and use information around them to acquire knowledge, understand the world around them, and make appropriate decisions.

5. Perceptual, Motor and Physical Development

Children will use their senses to gather and understand information and gain an increasing awareness of their bodies to perform tasks, explore their environment, and interact with people and things to keep themselves safe and healthy.
