Note: Palm Bay area Kids Ages 9-14 Years only!

Palm Bay Parks & Recreation in cooperation with Palm Bay Area Community Schools will host Palm Bay's Track and Field Mayor's Cup Track Meet on Saturday April 13, 2019 9AM-2PM at Palm Bay High School. Kids ages 9-14 are eligible to compete.

This Track Meet is for Palm Bay Community Schools **ONLY**, including Meadowlane Elementary, Central Jr. High, and Stone Middle School.

We invite your school's participation as a team with your leadership and as many volunteers as you can muster into public service to ensure this event is successful and fulfilling to our young participants.

An information packet is enclosed for your school from Palm Bay Track Headquarters. The information includes:

- Entry Forms with one white copy for making extra forms
- Event Cards, etc. (contact Keith Green @ 321-431-3887 or E-mail at greenksl@att.net)

Please review materials and consider representing your school in this special competition opportunity.

Awards will be for top 6 places for each event in each age group. Awards will be mailed to each School's Coordinator within a week with complete results.

There is NO FEE for participation, but all entrants must be enrolled and registered by their school's Physical Education Dept. and supported by school staff and volunteers to be eligible to compete.

Palm Bay Mayor's Cup Track Meet Director will be Coach Keith Green of Meadowlane Elementary. You may contact Mr. Green at 431-3887 or by Email at Greenksl@att.net

School scoring the most points for the track meet will be given the Mayor's Cup Trophy. Last year, Christa McAuliffe was the Champion. Mayor Capote gave the trophy to them at their school. Good luck to all schools this year!

The following preliminary information will help answer questions you may have. All participants must be 9-14 years old. Children will compete in school competition only at the local level. Track Clubs and other non-school organizations are NOT eligible for this event.

1. A schedule of events is enclosed. Remember, children may register in either (2) Track events and (1) Field Event; or (2) Field Events and (1) Track Event.
2. There is an important volunteer's meeting Saturday, April 13, 2019 at 8:30AM. Volunteers are crucial to our success and it's a requirement for participation. The Volunteers Meeting will be at the Palm Bay High School inner track area. See Coach Keith Green, Track Meet Director.
3. All Volunteers should check in prior to and no later than 8:30AM Saturday, prior to the meet starting at 9AM for last minute assignments and instructions.
4. All participants/teams must fill out and carry "Event Cards" with them prior to their competition starting time. The "Event Cards" will be available to all School Coaches prior to the Track Meet. Each child needs an event card for each event. Do not lose these cards and have them ready at each Event. They are important for Event Results. After each Event, turn in the cards to the "Results Area or Event Coordinator".
5. At the local Track Meet, there is no posting of results. Official tabulating of results will be done the following Monday & Tuesday. All schools will receive results and awards within a week to be presented by their PE teachers. If you do not receive them in a timely manner, call Coach Keith Green at 431-3887.
6. Each school must certify each student's age if requested. Age as of December 31, 2019 is the requirement.
7. Deadline for registration is Wednesday, April 10th 2019 at 5PM. ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT**

I/We, the parent(s)/guardian(s) of the undersigned child, on behalf of said child and ourselves do hereby assume all risks and hazards and all liability and responsibility incidental to any and all Palm Bay Mayors Cup Track and Field activities, including transportation to and from the activities, and do hereby waive and release, on behalf of our child and ourselves, and do hereby absolve to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Palm Bay, its employees, agents, and all others acting in their behalf, as well as all non-City employees and supervisors, and all persons involved in transporting the child to and from activities conducted by and on behalf of the City of Palm Bay, for any claim or damages or injury to the child arising out of the child's participation in any activities conducted by or sponsored by the City of Palm Bay. I/We agree to indemnify and hold harmless from any losses, costs, of whatever nature, including, but not limited to, attorney's fees and suit costs.

I/We also hereby grant permission to the City of Palm Bay, its agents, employees, representatives, assistants, and all other persons acting on behalf of the City of Palm Bay to authorize and obtain medical care from any physician or hospital, and/or medical clinic, should the child become ill or injured while participating in recreation activities sponsored, conducted, or supervised by the City of Palm Bay, should we or either of us not be available to specifically grant authorization for medical treatment.

I/We agree to pay for any and all damages done, caused or committed by our child, to the equipment, facility, supplies and/or other property utilized or owned by the City of Palm Bay including Palm Bay High School.

I/We acknowledge that I/We are familiar with and fully understand the rules set forth and prescribed by the City of Palm Bay's Parks & Recreation Dept. that govern the facility and use of facilities and property of the City of Palm Bay and the Brevard County School Board, and agree that our child is to abide by the City of Palm Bay's disciplinary rules and actions, should our child be involved in any infraction of such rules.
