

ATHLETIC COACHING

If you wish to be hired as a Community/Athletic Coach, you must complete these steps:

- 1) Apply to the FL DOE for your three year nonrenewable Athletic Coaching certificate. Here is their link: <http://www.fldoe.org/teaching/certification/on-line-application-status-lookup-site.stml>.

Use Internet Explorer 11 ONLY – Chrome and Firefox will NOT work.

- 2) Create and complete the Brevard Public Schools online application. Here is our link: <https://iss.brevard.k12.fl.us/AT000.pgm>

- 3) You must complete the following three trainings prior to your Temporary Certificate expiring.

Athletic Coaching Theory

Sports Specific Training

Sports Medicine – including a valid CPR card from the American Red Cross or American Heart Association.

The above three requirements can be met through the offices of Professional Learning and Development (free of charge **except** the CPR training).

OR you can take these courses online (except the CPR training) through American Sport Education Program (ASEP). The course costs vary ranging from \$50 - \$70 per course. Here is the link: www.HumanKineticsCoachEducationCenters.com

The three course titles through ASEP are:

Coaching Principles

(Sports Specific*) Technical and Tactical Skills

Sport First Aid

A valid CPR card from the American Red Cross or American Heart Association.

* *Sports Specific: the sport you are coaching such as Soccer, Basketball, Football, etc.*

After successfully completing the training and passing the written test, the participant must complete a hands-on skill evaluation with a currently certified Skill Evaluator/Instructor from ProTrainings LLC.

When the participant successfully passes the skill evaluation, the Skill Evaluator/Instructor signs or has his or her digital signature printed on the back of the card on the skill evaluator line. The Skill Evaluator/Instructor faxes the participant's skill evaluation checklist to ProTrainings LLC. After successful completion the participant is issued a certification valid for 2 years.
