### Important information:

- **Essay Topic:** The student is required to **handwrite** and upload a 150 -word minimum essay explaining why the student wants to participate in the Cambridge Program. The student must include information about their career and future educational plans. This essay is required to be uploaded and attached to the student's application. The student's application will NOT be considered complete until this essay has been received.
- **Fee:** A \$30.00 fee is charged to apply to this Choice Program for students that are NOT zoned for AJMS. If you ARE zoned for AJMS, you do not need to pay the fee.
- **Teacher Recommendations:** Please print 2 TEACHER recommendation forms. Please turn your recommendation forms with envelopes into your student's teachers before the end of the school year (Reading teacher and Math teacher). On the outside of the envelope, please write:

Your student's school will send it through the courier after they have completed it. The teachers will sign the sealed envelope to indicate that it is a confidential letter of recommendation.

If your school is unable to access the Brevard Public Schools courier or you are an out of county transfer student, then be sure to place a stamp on the envelope and address it properly before giving it to the teachers:

- Documents Required for Uploading: After your application has been submitted, you should receive an email from Scriborder. In that email, there will be a link. To access that link you must have your email address that you used to create the application, the password that you used, and the confirmation/order number you received after you successfully submitted your application.
- Once you have inputted that information, you will be able to upload the correct documents listed below:
  - End of 5<sup>th</sup> grade year report card for the 2017-18 school year
  - End of 6<sup>th</sup> grade year report card for the 2018-19 school year
  - 2018 and/or 2019 FSA Reading & Math scores
  - Handwritten Essay
