CELL PHONE POLICY

Effective February 27, 2023

STUDENTS ARE PROHIBITED FROM USING THEIR CELL PHONES, SMART WATCHES & HEADPHONES/EAR BUDS* DURING CLASS TIME FOR ANY REASON.

We expect students to switch their cell phones off or place them in silent mode during class. Phones must be out of sight in a purse or backpack.

Students who refuse to follow teacher direction to keep their cell phone off and out of sight during class time will receive school discipline as follows:

1st infraction: Administrative detention

2nd infraction: One day in school suspension (or hand in your phone to the dean's office the following day for the duration of the day)

3rd infraction: Two days in school suspension + suspension of the student's cell phone privilege for 30 days.

4th + infraction: Out of school suspension for willful disobedience + revocation of the student's cell phone privilege for the remainder of the school year.

Filming or recording students or staff without their permission will result in out of school suspension and revocation of the student's cell phone privilege for the remainder of the school year.

*Teachers may allow students to use their own headphones when they are required to complete a computer-based assessment and/or following IEP/504/ELL accommodations.
