Selection and qualification criteria:

- \$2,000 per scholarship
- Student must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Student must be attending a school in Brevard County alum (must have been in Brevard for 3 years)
- Community Service- 25 hours; must be *logged* and *signed off* on and submitted with application
- Student must have played a sport in high school
- Candidate qualities: Initiative, self-motivator, responsible, leader amongst peers
- Student must be a graduating senior (2023 graduation year)

The student will be responsible for completing and providing the following-

- Student name AND email address
- Student high school
- Short essay (1-2 pages) stating their career goals, why they chose to participate in sports, what sports have meant to them, what impact they have made with peers or in the community and why they believe they deserve this scholarship
- Letter of recommendation from a teacher or coach stating qualities that set this individual apart from his/her classmates
 - Are they responsible? Are they a resource and positive influence on their peers? Do they take initiative in the classroom/on the field? Are they kind?
- Community service log of 25 hours
