

# CONTINUE YOUR STUDIES AT EFSC!

If you are a graduating high school student who participated in Dual Enrollment, Collegiate High or earned Dual Enrollment Credits at your high school during your senior year – **these instructions are for you!**

***While you may not need to reapply to EFSC, there are some requirements you need to take care of to continue at EFSC once you graduate.***

- ❑ **PROOF OF HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION** - Depending on which semester you plan to attend after high school graduation, you will need to prove you are on-track to graduate or have graduated with a high school diploma. Here's how:

**Summer Term Courses** - Contact your guidance counselor to obtain a Graduation Pending Notification Form.

**Fall Term Courses** - EFSC will accept a copy of your diploma to allow you to register for the fall term. Request your final, official high school transcript with graduation date.

- ❑ **RESIDENCY** - Submit a [Residency Declaration](#) with copies of supporting documents.
- ❑ **MEET WITH YOUR ADVISOR** - You are encouraged to meet with an advisor to discuss degree requirements and placement testing options. To [schedule an advising appointment](#), log in to the myEFSC portal and make an appointment in the area marked "Student Services Appointments."
- ❑ **CONFIRM YOUR MAJOR** - Log in to your myGPS through myEFSC to make sure your major is correct. If you would like to change your major, submit a [Major Change Form](#) in myEFSC using the [Document Dropbox](#).
- ❑ **ADDRESS CHECK** - Log in to your myEFSC portal to confirm your mailing address is accurate. The Update Address link is under the Quick Links section.
