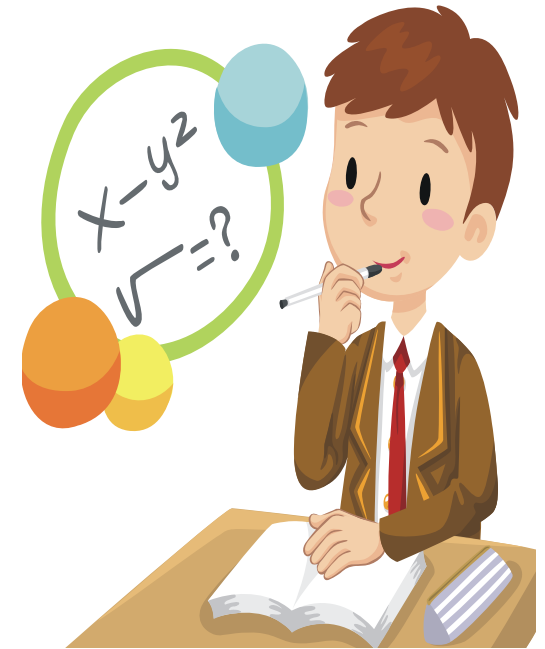
### About Us
