Five Star General	A student is nominated by the staff and must have a 3.5 GPA or higher for the year to be eligible, as well as, all O's and S's in conduct.	X
Spelling Bee	School-wide Spelling Bee winner and runner up	X
CCTS Science Award	"CCTS Excellence in Science Award." It is presented to a graduating student from each BPS Middle School, and is based on the student's science abilities, interests, and skills demonstrated during his/her Middle School experience. Abilities are reflected by the number and level of science courses taken and skills are demonstrated by high quality student research papers, participation in science fairs, membership in science-related clubs and other similar scientific endeavors. The rewarded student will receive a medal and certificate from CCTS representative at your school's annual award ceremony.	X
Most Improved	Each teacher has the opportunity to select two students for most improved academic achievement.	X
Most Outstanding	Each teacher has the opportunity to select two students for most outstanding academic achievement.	X
Student Government	Student government Elected Officers (year-long completion and completion of 5 community service hours per semester).	X
Top Media	The top three students who have read the most books in the school year.	X
Sunshine State Reader	Student who has read the most Sunshine State Books for the year.	X
Top Reader	ELA teacher selected student for top reader in each class based on books read and quizzes passed.	X
JOTV	Students who successfully complete the entire year working every day on the student news program.	X
