DRESS CODE

**WHAT IS APPROPRIATE AND WHAT IS
INAPPROPRIATE FOR SCHOOL CLOTHING
(INCLUDING HAIRSTYLES, MAKEUP AND PIERCINGS)**

UPPER GARMENTS

1. Garments must be of a length and fit that are suitable to the build and stature of the student. The cut of the sleeveless garments must not expose undergarment or otherwise be immodest.
2. Strapless garments are not allowed. Straps of allowed garments must be a minimum of 1 ½ inches in width (tube tops and halter tops are prohibited).
3. Necklines of all upper garments must be modest. Low cut necklines are not allowed.
4. Excessively large or baggy clothes are not allowed.
5. Upper garments must adequately cover the waistline and must not expose the midriff while the student is performing normal school-related activities (studying, retrieving books, raising hands, etc.)

LOWER GARMENTS

1. Pants shall fit the build and stature of a student; shall be worn at the waist and shall not extend below the heel of the shoe in length.
2. Undergarments shall not be visible. (sports bras are considered undergarments)
3. Dresses and skirts must reach mid-thigh or below in length with the waistband of skirts at waist level.
4. Shorts must have clearly discernible inseams of reasonable length and cover the buttocks. Short shorts are not allowed.

FOOTWEAR

1. Students *MUST* wear athletic shoes that are safe and appropriate for recess and physical education.
2. Flip flops and slides NOT ALLOWED, EVER.
3. Sandals should be limited to special days and should have a strap around the ankle

UNACCEPTABLE FOOTWEAR

These shoes are unacceptable due to safety during P.E. and outside recess. Students must bring athletic shoes for P.E. or outside recess.



UNACCEPTABLE ACCESSORIES

1. Clothing, jewelry and accessories shall not convey messages that are crude, vulgar or profane. They shall not be violent, death oriented, gang related, sexually aggressive. They may not promote alcohol, drugs or tobacco.
2. Dog collars, tongue rings, wallet chains, large hair picks, chains that connect one part of the body to another.
3. Jewelry or accessories that pose a safety concern for the student or others shall be prohibited.

Headwear

Hat and headscarves are not permitted to be worn on campus except during special event days, specials field days or when students are given special permission.



HAIR STYLES

Hairstyles should not be distracting.



MAKE UP

Makeup, if worn should be minimal if worn at all. It should not be distracting
