

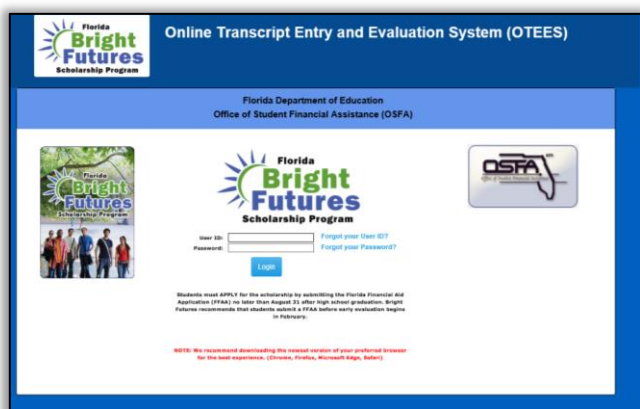
# Bright Futures Reports

Below are directions on how to access the Bright Futures Reports to track student progress. These reports can give you an overview of the current graduating seniors and potential eligibility for Bright Futures.

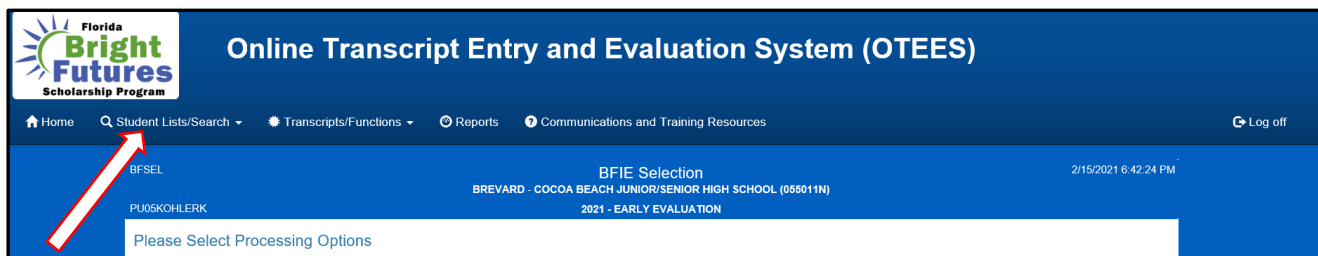
## Bright Futures Student Summary Report

Go to: <https://sso.osfaffelp.org/OSFASSO/BFIELogin.aspx?TARGET=CheckLogin> to access the online transcript entry and evaluation system. You can also access the website by going to the Bright Futures Scholarship website and click on the Bright Futures icon on the top left corner of the page.

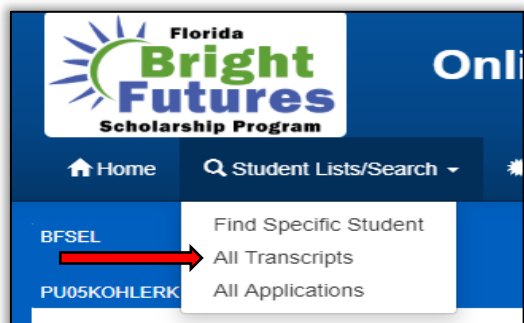
Log into Bright Futures- OTEES. Your user id and password will be the same for OTEES and OSFA.



From this main page you can select a student summary or generate reports. For a student summary, click on **Student Lists/Search**.



Click on **All Transcripts**



Click on **Student Transcript Report**

Two reports are now available, FAS/FMS and GSC/GSV. A report is generated to include FFAA status (bright future application status), student name, graduation date, test scores, GPA, community service hours, and potential award. This report can help find students who might qualify for BF but may be missing something such as test scores or community service hours. You can then print this report, export to an excel sheet, etc. (see 4<sup>th</sup> picture below). These reports can also be found under the “Reports” tab at the top of the main page.

This list displays all transcripts submitted to the Bright Futures evaluation system from your school.

Bright Futures evaluations are based upon official test scores. Test scores submitted through FASTER or entered online may be viewed on the Profile page, All Tests tab.

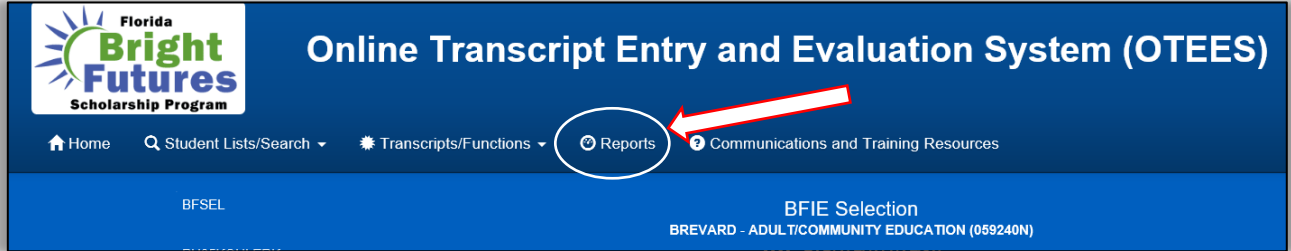

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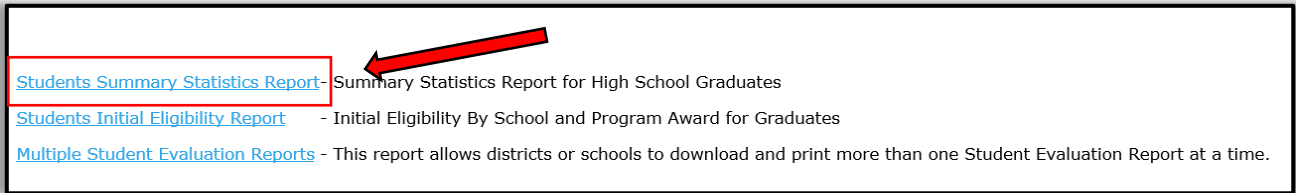
## Bright Futures Initial Eligibility Report

A summary page will open with the number of students that are currently eligible. Place cursor on the number and click to see a report of student names.

A new report will show student names and the current FFAA status. If the student shows “N”, these are the students that you will need to follow up with to ensure the Bright Futures application is completed.

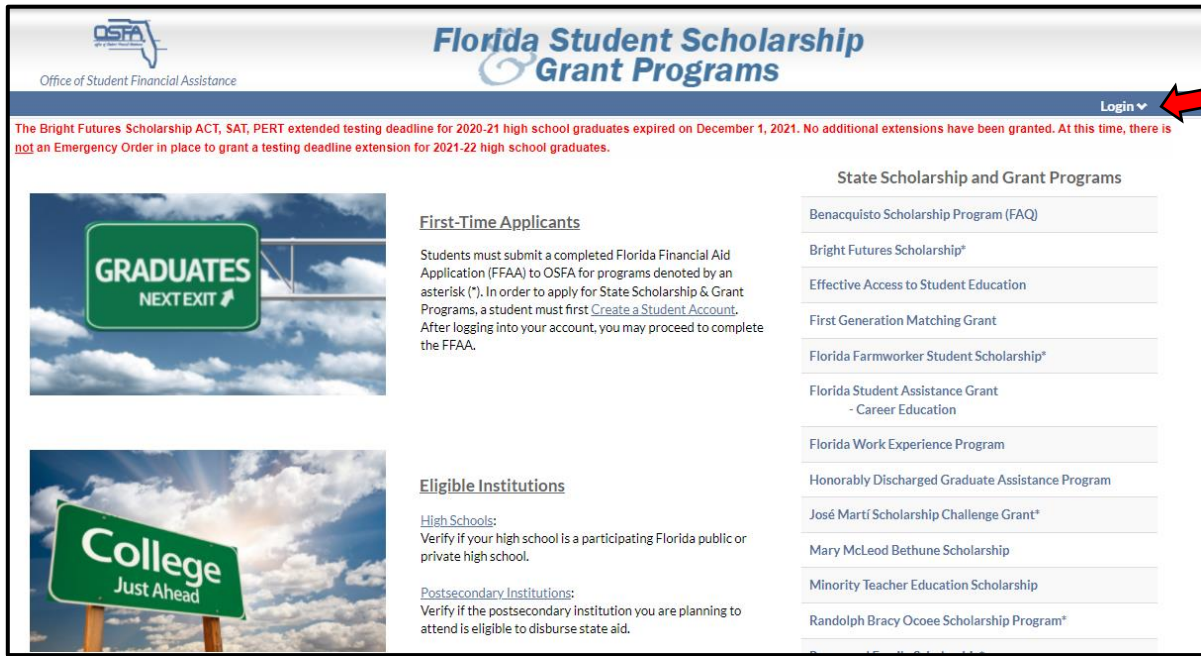

## Bright Futures Report including FAFSA

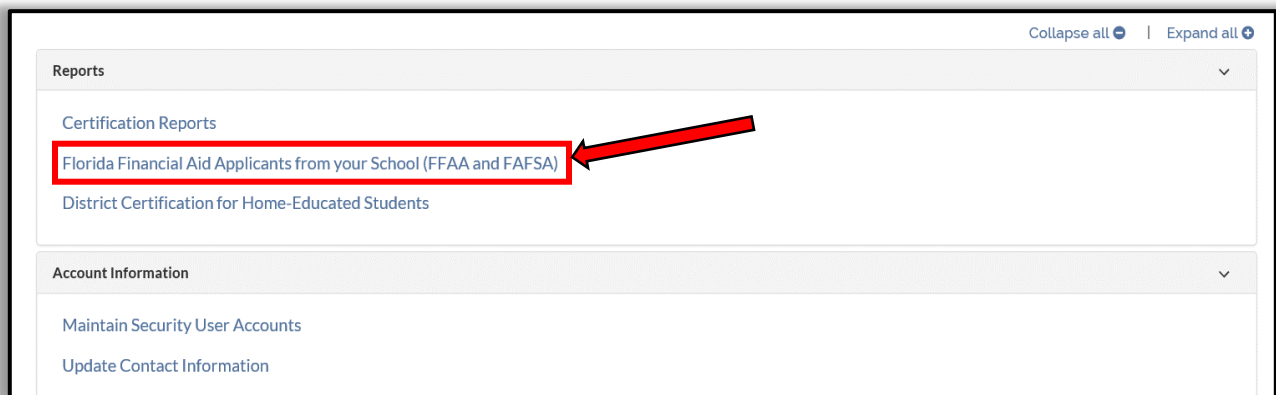
This report will give you information for Bright Futures as well as FAFSA information for each student. It is best to use Chrome when accessing this website.

Log into your OSFA account. Same login and password as OTEES.



Click **Florida Financial Aid Applications from your School (FFAA and FAFSA)**



Read and Agree to **Data Sharing Security Agreement**. Make sure that you select the school year the student will be using the financial aid. In the example, you will see the school year 2022-2023 is selected.
