

West Shore Jr/Sr High School College Algebra/College Trigonometry Dual Enrollment Contract

You have indicated interest in taking West Shore’s College Algebra/College Trigonometry class offered through EFSC. This course will earn you two (2) math credits at EFSC, all while staying on West Shore’s campus. However, in order to take this course, you must meet the EFSC conditions of dual enrollment:

- You must take and pass the PERT, ACT, or SAT
- You must pass the reading, writing, AND mathematics portions of the tests to take the course
- If you are using SAT/ACT to meet the eligibility, you must send your official SAT or ACT scores to EFSC ***before*** July 1st—no need to send them your PERT, as they have those
- You and a parent MUST attend the EFSC orientation of your choice NO LATER THAN JULY 15th. ***There will be NO orientation sessions allowed for students past this date. Failure to attend will result in you being placed in a different math course at West Shore. Dates for orientation are on the back of this document.***
- You must have and maintain a 3.0 unweighted GPA to register for the College Algebra/College Trigonometry courses and stay in the course for the spring semester
- The EFSC College Algebra/College Trigonometry course will start/continue your college transcript and be included in your high school GPA/transcript
- You will not be registered for the College Algebra/College Trigonometry course until you have returned this contract

I understand the conditions of the EFSC dual enrollment College Algebra/Trigonometry course. Failure to meet any of the above requirements at any time in the year will result in your removal from the course into a different West Shore math course.
