Mentoring is considered to be one of the most effective social-emotional intervention strategies for children who have either experienced trauma or are in need of an “extra leg-up” in life. We have a long list of referred students and a short list of volunteers.

What does it involve?

A commitment of 30 minutes a week during the school day

Eat lunch with the student

Talk

Play board games, basketball, baseball, etc.

Write haiku, poetry, or letters together

Color, draw, or do crafts

Encourage, motivate, support and navigate them towards a life of success

What are the personal qualifications needed to be a mentor?

Anyone who would like to invest in the lives of youth and empower students to reach their fullest potential!

Training and support will be provided and ongoing

What is the cost to be a mentor?

A background-check and fingerprinting by the school district (\$35.00) is required before there can be contact with students.
