Terriers,

We are excited to welcome back our students on Thursday, August 10th! Please remember, the campus will not be open to students until 8:00 AM. All students should be WEARING their ID Badges when they enter the school through the black gates between Building 1 and the Media Center. Please ensure your students are on time and dressed for success!

Curriculum:

Once school begins, August 10, 11, and 14th- counselors will be available during lunches in the media center to all students who are trying to get a schedule change. Schedule change request forms will be provided to students if it is not a quick fix.

Please consider the following before submitting a schedule change request form:

- A teacher change for the same course or request for a different lunch period will not be considered
- Other classes may be moved to accommodate this request
- Once a schedule change is made it may not be changed back
- Only one request form per student
- If it's a course you requested the change will not be made

An email will be sent to students that provides a status update of schedule change request form by Friday, August 18th. Please be patient as requests may take up to one week to process.

No schedules will be changed after close of school on Friday, August 18th.

Operations:

Bus Loop: Due to roofing and drainage construction projects which will begin in the fall, the bus loop will be moved to the Auditorium loop at the NE section of the school parking lot. Beginning August 10, please be aware of the following changes to this area:

- From 8:15am 9am and 3:15pm 4pm, the north gate (by Kim's Donuts) will be for bus entrance only.
 Only busses may enter and exit from the north gate during these time windows.
- 2. Cones will designate off-limit areas in the parking lot. Please respect these cones and make sure your students understand that the cones are limiting access to certain areas at certain times.
- 3. The Auditorium bus loop parking spaces will be designated for **Staff Parking Only**. However, there will be no gate access during the bus transportation windows above.

Student Parking: Due to shipping delays, the district has not yet received the parking decals in time for us to sell them during registration. After school is in session, students will be able to purchase a parking pass in the media center before/after school and during their lunch. They will need to bring their driver's license, car registration, and car insurance. Cost is \$20, cash only and no bills larger than a twenty.

Entering Campus: Students should enter campus through the black gates between Building 1 and the Media Center. All students will be checked at the gate to ensure they are WEARING their Student ID Badges. Students not in compliance will be sent to the Attendance Office to purchase a new ID Badge if a replacement is needed. Replacement badges are \$5.00.

Exiting Campus: Students who leave before the end of the day must exit through the Attendance office.

Student Lunches: Please see the lunch information table in the cafeteria during registration for menus, cost, and free/reduced lunch information.

Dean's Office:

Cell Phone/Electronic Device Policy:

- Students may use cell phones before school, after school, during their assigned lunch, and during class changes.
- Cell phones **must be turned off and out of sight during class times**, which are indicated by the late bells and dismissal bells.
- Students are prohibited from using cell phones during class time.

ID Badge Policy: Students must always <u>wear</u> their ID badges while on campus. Every student will receive an ID Badge and lanyard at registration. Students who lose their ID Badge will have to purchase a new one through the Attendance Office for \$5.00.

Student Dress Code: Hats can be worn outdoors only. Shirts must be worn at all times. Undergarments must not be exposed. Chest, midriff, and back should be covered at all times. Clothing, jewelry, and accessories shall not convey messages that are crude; vulgar/profane; violent/death-oriented; gang related; sexually suggestive; and/or promote alcohol, drugs, or tobacco.
