From the Dean's Office:

Reminder Regarding Headgear: Hats and related headgear are not allowed on campus. Parents or guardians must come to the school to retrieve items that have been confiscated.

Tardy Policy: Students are given ample time to transition between classes. The vast majority of students are adhering to tardy expectations. Listed below are the consequences for failure to comply with our tardy expectations.

1st Tardy – Teacher Warning

2nd Tardy – Detention and Parent Contact

3rd Tardy – Teacher Referral to administration

Subsequent Tardies – Student moves up the discipline ladder

ID Badge Policy: Students must always wear their ID badges while on campus during the instructional day. Students use their ID Badges for buses, purchasing lunch, checking out materials from the media center, and to check in and out of classes.

Dress Code Policy: The students of Titusville High School are expected to dress in a manner that is supportive of a positive learning environment that is free of distractions and disruptions and it's not hazardous to others or school property. Any clothing or accessories that are viewed as distracting because of extremes in style, fit, color, pattern, material design, message etc., shall not be permitted. Students who are not dressed appropriately will be referred to the Dean, and the student's parent will have to bring in an appropriate set of clothing before the student will be permitted back into the classroom. Cell Phone Policy: Cellular phones and electronic devices must be silenced and out of sight during instructional time unless a teacher has approved cell phone use for instructional activities. Students may use their cell phones during their lunch period and during the five-minute transition between blocks. Students **may not** record video or take pictures of other students without prior approval from administration. At no time during cell phone/ electronic utilization should another individual be able to hear the noise from the device including but not limited to conversations, music, ringing etc. Additional info is listed in the student handbook and planner.
