TESTING

The F.A.S.T. Reading Progress Monitoring Window 1 closes Friday, September 9. This assessment is a requirement for all 9th and 10th grade students. Makeup testing will continue throughout the coming week and it is crucial that any 9th or 10th grade student that has not taken it yet attends their assigned testing session.

Operations:

The use of student parking decals will be enforced beginning Tues., Sept. 6. Permits are available in the Media Center. Students will need to present a proof of auto insurance, driver's license, and \$20 cash to purchase a decal. Students with current obligations must clear their obligations before purchasing a parking decal. Beginning September 6, students parking without a decal will receive the following:

- 1st ticket for no decal - Dean's Referral
- 2nd ticket for no decal - \$5 fine
- 3rd ticket for no decal - \$10 fine
- 4th ticket for no decal - Placement on the discipline ladder, including prohibition from future parking on campus.

In addition, students and parents should familiarize themselves with the parking lot regulations on pgs. 15-16 of the Student Handbook, and be aware that vehicles are subject to search.

Tardy Policy: Students are given ample time to transition between classes. The vast majority of students are adhering to tardy expectations. Listed below are the consequences for failure to comply with our tardy expectations.
