CURRICULUM CORNER:

Open Enrollment Procedures for 2021-2022 ELO/EPO

(Education Location and Education Program Options)

The application timeline to apply for EPO or ELO is from January 4 – February 26, 2021. The deadline to submit the renewal application is **February 26, 2021**. If you fail to complete the application on time, your student will have to go to their zoned school for the 2021-22 school year.

E-Learning Update:

E-Learning is only to be used for Covid-19 related reasons. All E-Learning must be approved by students' counselors so that their status may be properly updated and teachers may be informed. In addition, parents of E-Learners who failed to make adequate progress August – January were required to meet with counselors to plan their students' return to campus for face-to-face learning beginning in January. In the near future, these students whose parents did NOT meet with guidance will NOT be allowed to Zoom into classes. Therefore, if you received a letter that your student must return to campus and have not yet contacted guidance, **please do so immediately.**

Additional Requirements for E-Learning

- Students should establish a remote learning workspace in the home prior to the start of each school day. Students should be seated in a chair at a table or desk. Logging in from a moving car or while in bed is not permitted.
- Cameras must be in good working order and turned on at all times. Failure to use cameras will result in an absence.
- Microphones must also be in working order. We recommend headphones to minimize distractions.
- Virtual backgrounds must be school appropriate.
- Students should be wearing school appropriate attire (no pajamas or revealing clothing).
- Materials should be ready before class begins.
- On-campus rules and expectations apply to E-Learners, including cell phone use.
- E-Learners must log in at the beginning of each scheduled class time. Please be patient while teachers take attendance for in-person learners and admit E-Learners to the virtual classroom.
- E-Learners are **required** to participate in MAP progress monitoring and standardized assessments **on-campus.**
