- **Important Announcement About PERT Testing for Dual Enrollment!**
10th, 11th, and 12th grade students who need to take the PERT test to be eligible to enroll in spring classes at EFSC must sign up at:

The PERT tests in reading, writing and math. First time Dual Enrollees should sign up for all three tests. If returning Dual Enrollment students don't know which tests to take, they should reach out to their guidance counselor ASAP before signing up.

Once on the site, click on "Parents." You will then you will see a link that says "2020 Student PERT Registration Form." Complete and submit the form. The form MUST be submitted **no later than November 5th**, and it will be date and time stamped. We realize this is a short turn-around time, but the district just worked out the specifics with EFSC and the schools!

We will test for the PERT on campus at THS on **November 12th and 19th ONLY**. Students who sign up will be notified of their assigned date by Mrs. Roberts. Testing will begin at 8:30am sharp in lab 1-141. Students should plan to arrive on campus by 8:15am. The tests are self-paced.
