- All 10th grade students and 9th/11th graders who signed up for the PSAT will test on Wed., Oct. 14th. Students should arrive to school before the initial bell and report directly to their testing location. Rosters will be displayed in front of the cafeteria at the beginning of next week for on-campus learners. Testing locations will be sent to eLearners through Focus. Students must bring their ID. It is optional to bring a graphing calculator, water, and a snack. Study guides are still available in the cafeteria during lunch for on-campus students and in the Front Office for eLearners.

RULES**From the Dean's Office**

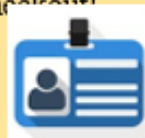
- Parents may not drop-off items for student pick-up that are not medically or academically required.
- Students who have 3 or more absences, in any course, will be receiving a notice in FOCUS. Students can pick-up an FA Appeals Packet (Failure due to Absences) in the Attendance Office on Wednesday, October 14th before school, after school, or during lunch. **All FA Appeals Packets will be due back to the Attendance Office no later than Friday, October 16th.**

TITUSVILLE TERRIERS**ATTENTION – NEW PROCEDURE!!!**

This year when students exit campus, for Dual Enrollment or any other purpose, you will need to check out in the Attendance Office using your student ID badge and the scanners. This will allow us to track who is leaving THS campus each day and their time of departure.

The enforcement of this policy began the second week of school after ID badges are distributed. Once you receive your ID badge, remember to wear it on your lanyard every day as it will also be used for Hall Passes, in the cafeteria for lunch, and the media center for book checkout.

Replacement ID Badges will be \$5.
