### Important Information about Mid-Term Exams for E-Learners:

To preserve the academic integrity of mid-term exams, E-Learners may choose one of the following options for mid-term exams:

1. **E-Learners may test at home provided that they have an operational webcam and microphone.** Both **must be turned on during the entirety of the test.** Student access to cell phones during testing is **strictly prohibited.** Tests submitted by students who do **NOT** turn on their camera/microphone or who utilize cell phones during testing will **NOT** be graded.
2. **E-Learners who do NOT have an operational camera/microphone to use during the exam will need to arrange to take their tests on-campus and in-person during the regularly scheduled class time,** because students without these working devices cannot be adequately monitored during testing. These students should notify their teachers that they will be coming to campus to test, check into attendance with their ID, and report to class at the scheduled time of their exam.
3. E-Learning students should check each teacher's Focus account for specific directions about mid-term exams.

Quarter 1 grades will be posted on Focus on Wednesday, October 28, and hard copies of report cards will be distributed in students' 2<sup>nd</sup> block classes on Tuesday, November 3. Report cards for E-Learners will be available in the Front Office on Thursday, November 5.
