If your student will be enrolled in Algebra, Geometry, or Liberal Arts Math at any time this year, they are required by state statute to take the MAP three times per year. Students benefit because the MAP provides data for teachers to individualize instruction!

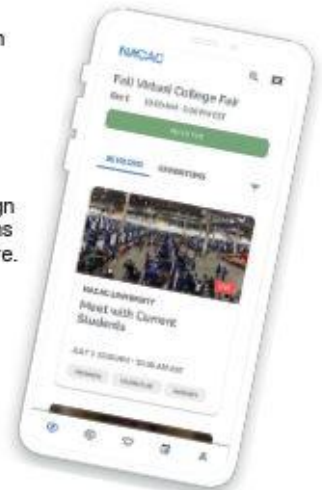

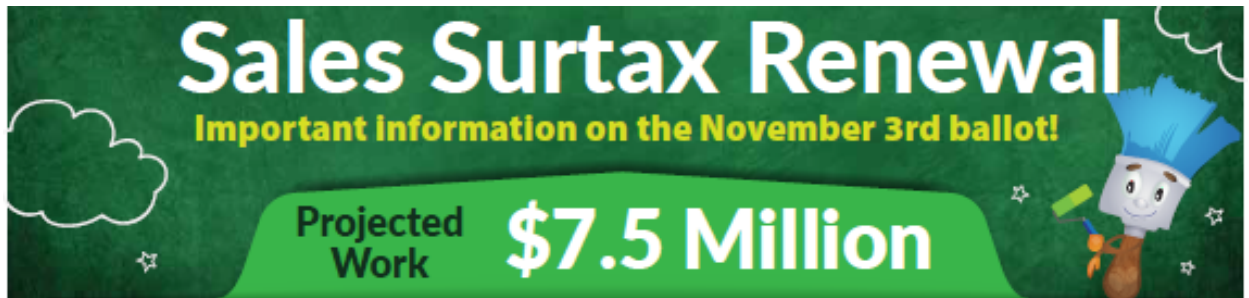
