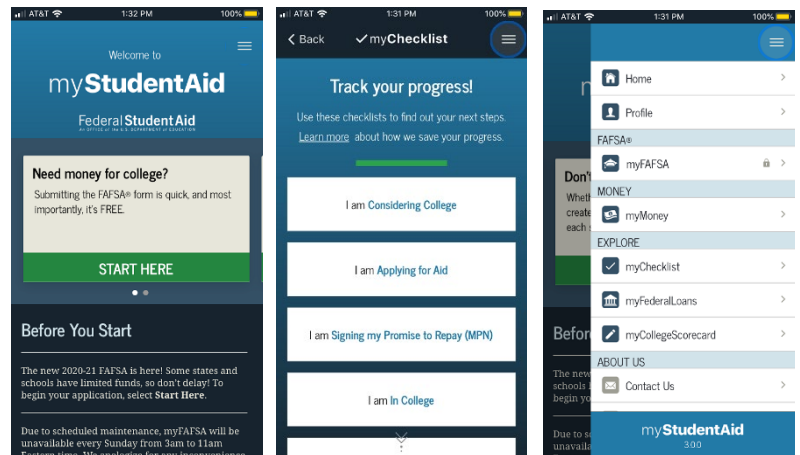


# Completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid on the myStudentAid Mobile App

There is no excuse for not applying for financial aid for college – especially with the new mobile app offered by the U.S. Department of Education. No matter how busy you are, you can complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) anytime, anywhere!

## Instructions

- Download the app:
- For iOS devices, download the app from the Apple App Store.
- For Android, download from Google Play.
- Provide your FSA ID to access the myFAFSA functionality on the mobile app. If you don't have an FSA ID, you will be able to create one.



## Features

- Profile: Edit/manage an FSA ID
- myFAFSA: Complete the FAFSA safely and securely from your mobile device
- myMoney: Future enhancements are planned for managing your money
- myChecklist: Track your progress on your path, from considering college through repaying your student loans
- myFederalLoans: View federal student loan and aid history
- myCollegeScorecard: View and compare information about schools
- Contact Us: Contact information for FSA's contact centers
- StudentAid.gov: Access information about the federal student aid programs, application process, and loan repayment options

## Tips

- Make sure you complete it on a secure WiFi (password required)
- Make sure to update the app. For example, if you downloaded the app before September 29, 2019, you'll need the updated version to be able to access the 2020-21 FAFSA.
