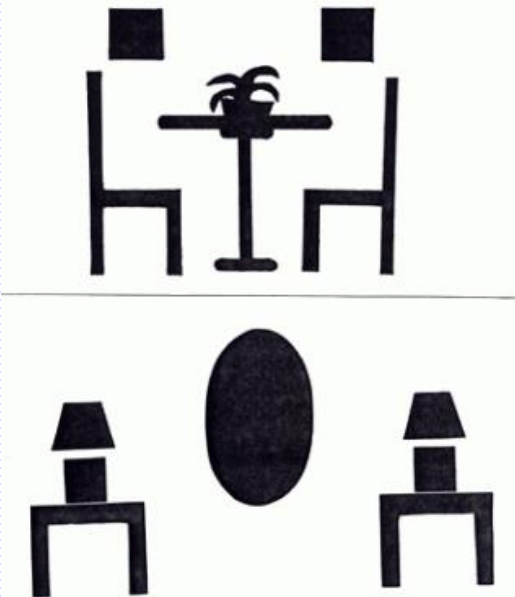

◆ Fashion Design and Interior Design students begin learning Design Principles and **basic sewing skills** and progress to more advanced interior and fashion techniques while studying all aspects of the respective industry including **employment opportunities**; basic leadership and organizational skills; selection, usage and care of tools, equipment and supplies; textile characteristics and care; safety procedures; pattern design, operation and maintenance of conventional, computerized, serger and commercial **sewing machines**. Hand and computer drafting skills, rendering, and presentation skills. Reading and math skills are addressed throughout the course work.

◆ Because classroom laboratory activities are an integral part of this program, fashion **students will be completing projects costing money.** Interior students will be completing several projects which also may involve some expense. Program t-shirts may be available for purchase, if the students decide to design one, with any income being used to purchase class supplies. If there is a financial difficulty in which you are unable to purchase the necessary supplies, please see me prior to the due date and supplies will be provided confidentially.

- ◆ Students should keep a portfolio of all work done. They may use it as they continue through the program or for scholarships, college admission and jobs.
- ◆ The portfolio can be made up of digital images of work.



◆ Labs are an integral part of this course. Students will be responsible for working on the assigned project the **entire** class period. A daily class participation grade will be earned according to the student's performance. A deduction will be taken for each day the project is late and for each day that a student does not work on a project. **No sewing project may be taken home to work on without my permission.** The daily grade is part of the overall project grade.
