PARADE LINE UP: Staff and volunteers from the S.B. Recreation Dept. will help line up all parade units at the DeLaura Middle School parking lot, Jackson Ave., Satellite Beach. Be sure all participants arrive no later than 10:00am. Come earlier if you require extra preparation time. See diagram attached for the specific line up area where your group should meet.

PARADE STEPS OFF AT 11:00a.m., Saturday, November 6th.

PARADE ROUTE: Please note the location of the judges' stand has moved to in front of the DRS main entrance doors NOT on Jackson Ave.

Exit DeLaura

West on Jackson

South on Orange

Cross Roosevelt

Continue South on Orange

West on Park

North on Avocado

Cross Roosevelt

West on Jackson

North into the DRS Community Center parking lot

End at DRS Community Center

*Judges stand will be located at main entrance to the DRS Community Center building facing the parking lot of the DRS.

Please keep performance at judges' stand to **2-minutes.**

PARADE PARTICIPATION AWARDS: Awards will be presented at approximately 1pm near the DJ station located in the DRS parking lot. Parade participant winners will be announced and given their award by Mayor Steve Osmer. **Please be sure a representative from your group is present.**

AWARD CATEGORIES ARE: School Spirit Junior Participants, School Spirit Senior Participants, Civic Spirit Award- Youth, Civic Spirit Award – Adult, Best Business, Most Entertaining, Best Decorated, Originality Award.

PARADE PARTICIPANT DROP-OFF: Parade participants may be dropped off in front of the DeLaura Middle School front door. Please refrain from stopping your vehicle on DeLaura Lane as this holds up the through traffic. Pass this information on to ALL your participants and parents. If you are a parent who must walk their child to their group's meeting place – please park your car at Satellite High School or at some location other than DeLaura, and then walk around until you find your child's group.

PARKING: All vehicles not in the parade MUST park in the Satellite High School parking lot, or at some location other than DeLaura. Questions usually arise regarding parking and entry to the parade line up area. Please read the instructions on the map carefully and pass these instructions on to all participants of your group, especially to the parents that are just dropping off children.

PARADE END / PICK UP: The parade route ends at the David R. Schechter Community Center; 1089 S. Patrick Dr. between 11:45 and 12:45 (depends on your placement in the parade). Floats may park in the grassy area north of the DRS building for off loading and display. For safety reasons, please do not stop in the DRS parking lot to off load. (see attached map)

RAIN PLANS: If it has been raining, but has stopped by 11:00am we will proceed with the parade. If it is pouring, the parade will be cancelled. There is no make-up day.

SATELLITE BEACH WOMAN'S CLUB MARKETPLACE: Our Founder's Day Parade coincides with SB Woman's Club Craft Show, which will run 9am - 3pm. There is no entry fee to the craft show. In addition to the craft show, the activities at the DRS Community Center will include music, lunch and festival food, and farmers market. Face art, kid's games and other fun activities are planned for a nominal fee. Don't miss the fun!
