School <u>academic</u> goal(s) and/or focus area(s) All learners will be exposed to on-grade level content via Benchmark Universe (ELA) and Florida REVEAL (Math). Endeavour Elementary is focusing on improving proficiency and learning gains via high quality grade level instruction, student exposure, and practice aligned to BEST standards for the 2023-24 School Improvement Plan (SIP). 2023 - 2024 academic goals include: In grades K - 2, increase ELA proficiency by 14 percent and Math proficiency by 11 percent; in grades 3-6 increase ELA proficiency by 21 percent and Math proficiency by 15 percent; and in grade 5 increase State Science Assessment proficiency by 17 percent.

Students, parents/guardians will keep current through texts, emails, phone calls, or the Endeavour web page.
