

## Busing for 2023 Summer school & more

Summer school bus stops are DEPOT stops, which means busing is to a centralized bus location. Unlike previous school years where we have had numerous bus stops, these stops might be further from your home. A parent/guardian may choose any DEPOT stop for their student to get to the school they are attending. Bus information is for the following summer programs:

- Third Grade Reading Camp
- Elementary Summer Acceleration Program (KG through 5th grade)
- ESOL/Title III Summer Enrichment Center
- Magnetic Reading
- Let's Go Wild about Literacy Summer Literacy Program
- Primary and Secondary Enrichment Programs
- 6th Grade Course Recovery
- Summer Fine Arts Workshops
- Seniors in High School ESOL Summer Program
- Secondary Summer Acceleration Program (7th through 12th grade)
- Secondary Summer Recovery Program (7th through 12th grade)

**\*Bus stops listed are good for the week only! Parents/students MUST check back EVERY WEEKEND to verify if a bus stop is still available. Transportation will be actively monitoring the stop load, and if no student is using a bus stop, it will be removed the following week.**

Bus badges from this school year will be used for summer school, please keep them safe. If you do not have a badge, the Student ID number must be entered into the tablet when boarding and exiting the bus every time.

Parents are required to request bus transportation online via a Google Form. The link below will provide you with all of the information including where the bus stop will be. McAuliffe will be a bus stop and there may be others that are close to your home. Be sure to click the **Elementary Summer Depot stop on the right hand corner** to check where the stops will be. **Your child will be attending Jupiter Elementary**, so be sure to look at the stops attached to that school.
