Introductions

Hello Indialantic Families, This is Dr. Braga the Principal of Indialantic. Today I would like to share information on what we are doing to prepare for the upcoming school year.

Four Learning Options

- Full Time Learning in School. Students attend Indialantic five days a week in a brick and mortar classroom.
- Full Time E-Learning from School. Students will maintain enrollment at Indialantic. Children will learn and collaborate with their peers in a virtual platform following a traditional school day schedule. Academics, CAMP, Recess, Lunch, etc will be at the same time of day that the in-school grade level students are following. This allows are grade level teachers to plan together.
- Full Time Brevard Virtual School. Students will be enrolled at BVS and complete coursework during the hours that are most convenient for the student. Students will not have live interaction with their teacher or peers.
- Part Time In-Person and Part Time Brevard Virtual School.

Please call Dr. Braga or Mr. Roddenberry with any questions or concerns you have about the learning options and what we are doing at our school site to ensure all students and staff are safe and students are engaged in learning.

Registration

We have changed registration to allow parents to virtually register. If you would like to register in person, please call the front office for an appointment time. We will be sending out a virtual registration link

on Monday. This link will provide access to all the information that you would normally receive during a school based registration day. It is important to indicate which learning option your child will be participating in this school year. Thank you to everyone who completed the survey indicating your choice between e-learning, BVS, or brick and mortar. This helps us to plan more effectively to meet your child's needs.

Safety Protocols

We are developing plans for your child's safety such as one way hallways. We are working on staggered dismissal times. We have decluttered the classrooms. The students will be seated in desks all facing in the same direction. The cafeteria has been rearranged with all tables facing in the same direction to provide for spaced seating and social distancing. Cleaning protocols are in place for all areas of the school such as classrooms, high traffic areas, and restrooms. Families are encouraged to use the carline as the safest way to ensure students are social distancing, but students can still walk or bike to school if that is your choice.
