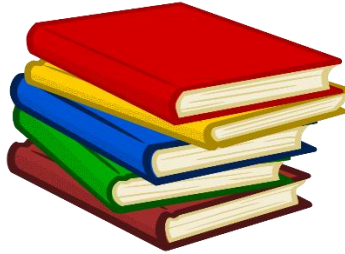


# Roosevelt Elementary

\* Students who raise **\$75.00** will be given a day to wear a **crazy hat** or **crazy hair** day. (date TBA)

\* Students who raise **\$100.00** will be given a day to **dress wacky**. (date TBA & must be school appropriate)

\*Top reader in each class who reads the most minutes will receive a **certificate, free ice cream, and bragging rights all year!**

\*Top reading class with the most minutes will receive a **PJ/Read/Movie half day**. (date TBA)

\* Top reader in each grade level with the most minutes will receive up to **\$10.00 for a book of their choice and certificate**.

\* Any class that raises **\$1,000.00 or more** will receive a class grant of **\$125.00**.
