(10/26/20 - 10/30/20)

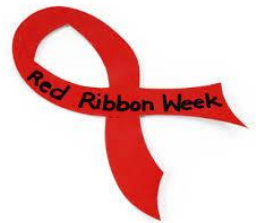
Monday-10/26: It's Red Ribbon Week: wear red to kick this week off!
