Message from the Principal

Parents, I want to make you aware of House Bill 107, which is listed below. This bill prohibits using wireless communications in a handheld manner while driving through a school zone.

CS/House Bill 107: Wireless Communications While Driving

prohibiting a person from operating a motor vehicle while using a wireless communications device in a handheld manner in a designated school crossing, school zone, or work zone; authorizing a law enforcement officer during a specified period to stop motor vehicles to issue warnings to persons who are driving while using a wireless communications device in a handheld manner in a designated school crossing, school zone, or work zone; requiring all law enforcement agencies to maintain such information and report it to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles in a form and manner determined by the department, etc.
