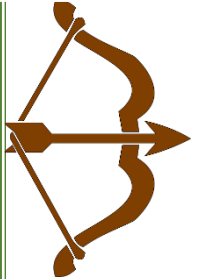

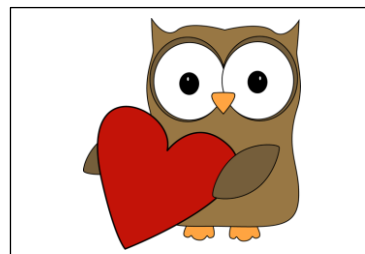
Dear Families,

- The deadline for submission of completed AVID applications is March 1.
- Acceptance/denial/wait notices for AVID will be sent via email to the address listed on the application the week of April 11.
